Data Protection Act 2018/1050, EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679.

This document clarifies and specifies the information on the processing of personal data on a research or project-by-project basis. The privacy statement helps ensure the data controller's obligation to demonstrate compliance. Demonstrating compliance is a key principle in the data protection regulation, meaning that the data controller must be able to prove that they adhere to data protection act.

3. What is the purpose for which my personal data is processed?

Scientific research is one of Xamk's basic tasks. Personal data are processed based on customer collaboration and statutory obligations as part of the project activities, including the implementation of research, development and innovation (RDI) activities and the collection of data to assess project impacts and achievement of objectives.

The processing of personal data is based on the information provided by the participant when participating in the project activities and the information collected for the funder in accordance with the funder's instructions.

4. On what basis is my personal data processed?

The basis for processing personal data is the public interest (scientific research and the research, development, and innovation activities of universities of applied sciences).

The processing of personal data in scientific research is based on the general EU data protection regulation as well as national data protection law. Scientific research is a task **in the public interest** within the meaning of the Data Protection Regulation, in which case scientific research in the public interest is the basis for the processing of personal data (Data Protection Act). In the Data Protection Regulation (recital 159), the concept of research also covers RDI activities.

5. Name, nature, duration and performers of the study or project

Project name: Securing the future with resilient information

Nature: Development project

Project duration: 1.1.2026 – 31.8.2027

Performers: Project staff at South-Eastern Finland University of Applied Sciences (Xamk), the National Archives of Finland and Central Archives for Finnish Business Records (ELKA).

Securing the future with resilient information project is Co-funded by the European Union. The funding has been granted by the South Savo Regional Council.

6. Parties of the development project and division of responsibilities

The project will be implemented as a joint project between Xamk, the National Archives of Finland and Central Archives for Finnish Business Records (ELKA).

Xamk: Project communication, information, coordination and reporting, project events such as organisation and marketing of workshops, implementation of stakeholder and feedback surveys, and dissemination of information about project pilots and results.

7. What kind of data about me is processed?

The personal data required to maintain the project's stakeholder and customer relationships are the person's name, organisation and contact information. Contact information is used for managing customer relationships, event management, project-related information and communications, the marketing of workshops and events, as well as for stakeholder and feedback surveys. Personal data is collected only to the extent necessary for the implementation of the project.

The following data are collected from companies and organizations participating in the project: the name and business ID of the company/organization, postal address, telephone number, locality, and the names and email addresses of contact persons.

The project does not process special categories of personal data (sensitive personal data).

The project's RDI activities focus on mapping and developing methods and approaches to ensure the reliability and availability of information, as well as on developing the operations of participating organizations through the application of these solutions. In situations where project partners make material potentially containing personal data available to the project for

development, its processing and protection will be agreed upon by a separate agreement between the parties, if necessary, specifying the terms of the processing of personal data.

8. From what sources is my data collected?

Personal data is collected directly from the data subjects themselves. Data is collected using forms (surveys, registration and participation forms for events and workshops), interviews and by e-mail.

9. Will my personal data be disclosed to third parties?

The personal data is not regularly disclosed to other parties. In accordance with the project plan and the project's funding conditions, data - such as participant information - may be disclosed to the project funder (the Regional Council of South Savo).

10. Is my data processed outside the EU or the EEA?

Data will not be transferred by the controller outside the EU or the EEA.

The pilot data set processed within the project is handled on infrastructure managed by the Research Centre for Digital Information Management Digitalia, located in a secured and access-controlled data centre in Mikkeli. Access to the server environment is restricted to individuals who have been explicitly authorized.

Xamk uses Microsoft cloud services (Teams and OneDrive) as storage space. Generally, Microsoft processes data in the EU / EEA and in regional data centers. 11. How long will my data be kept?

Personal data will be retained for the duration of the project and as long as there is still a need for their use. In project activities, personal data will be stored according to the archiving period required by the funders. Project materials and data, which may also contain personal data, will be archived according to Xamk's practices: in EU-funded projects, the retention period requirement is 10 years after the end of the program period.

12. How is my personal data protected?

The personal data of people involved in the project is stored in information systems where users have personal user IDs. The data in the system can only be accessed and used by those persons of the registrar who have the right to do so on behalf of their work. The employees of the project are committed to confidentiality and to keeping confidential the information obtained in connection with the processing of personal data.

At Xamk, Microsoft cloud services (Outlook, Teams, and OneDrive) are used for data storage, and data generated on the basis of customer relationships are stored in these services.

Contact requests submitted via the project website are stored on the WordPress platform.

Customer and stakeholder data is stored in a customer management system, where the maintenance of the data is protected by an ID and a password. The data stored in the system is used by a group limited by user rights in the register.

The information security and confidentiality of the personal data have been ensured by appropriate technical and administrative measures in accordance with good data processing practice.
