

## STUDENT SELECTION, Supplementary application in autumn 2019

The student selection in the supplementary application round for the Degree Programme in Wellbeing Management beginning in January 2020 is based on **CV/Portfolio and motivation video**.

**The supplementary application is only open for applicants with a qualification completed in Finland.**

The maximum points in student selection are 40 and the minimum requirement for a passed result is 10 points. Applicant must pass all parts of the student selection.

To be considered in the student selection, the applicant also needs to submit an application form for the study programme in Studyinfo.fi service during the application period **2 - 5 December 2019** (by 3 pm EET) and meet the eligibility requirement for the studies (suitable qualification completed in Finland).

The CV/Portfolio and motivation video include the following **three parts** that must be submitted **by 12 December 2019** at <https://asiointi.xamk.fi/lomakkeet/857/lomake.html>

**Please save your documents and video link all in one submission.**

### 1. Copy of passport or official ID card

### 2. CV/Portfolio

Include a recent facial photo of yourself in the CV (can be informal photo). Europass CV format is recommended, please see instructions for it here:

In a case an applicant wishes to create a portfolio instead of CV, the portfolio document needs to include the following: a recent facial photo of yourself (can be informal photo), personal information (name, date and place of birth, contact details), education and training background, work experience, personal skills (mother tongue, language skills, digital skills, hobbies or personal interests).

### 3. Motivation video

The motivation video is a video you make of yourself, answering the questions given below. You can make the video with the device of your choice (e.g. mobile phone, tablet, digital camera). The duration of the video is max. 2 minutes. Upload your video on YouTube and share a link for it when submitting the passport/ID card and CV/portfolio.
