

Video interview: Environmental Engineering studies

This video interview replaces the entrance exam for environmental engineering studies. You have to **personally appear** on the video answering the questions listed below.

Begin the video by **introducing yourself** and showing your **identification** card/passport on the screen. Both your name and picture should be clearly visible. Speak clearly and to the point. The **maximum** length of your video is **3 minutes**.

You can make the video with the device of your choice (e.g. mobile phone, tablet, digital camera). Upload your video on YouTube as an unlisted video. Ensure that the video is available to be watched until 30 September 2020.

Interview questions:

1. Briefly introduce your educational background:
 - Which degrees you have completed?
 - How did you succeed in these studies?
 - How advanced are your IT skills?
2. What is your professional aim (e.g. a dream job) for the future?
3. How will studying environmental engineering at Xamk help you reach this aim?
4. Is there anything else you would like us to consider?

Submitting the video interview:

1. Upload your video on YouTube as an unlisted video. Remember to test that your link works for sure.
2. Take a photo or scan of your passport or official ID card.
3. Submit the link to your video and an electronic copy of your passport/official ID card **by Sunday 9 August 2020 23:59 (Finnish time, EEST)** at <https://asiointi.xamk.fi/lomakkeet/1149/lomake.html>

Note! We need to be able to watch the video directly from the link you have provided (without the need of uploading the actual video file).

Application form on Studyinfo.fi:

In addition to the video link and passport/ID card, you are required to submit the application form on Studyinfo.fi service during the application period and meet the eligibility requirement for the studies. The additional application period is:

- **3 - 6 August 2020** (by 3 pm Finnish time, EEST)
